NINCHERI’S SECULAR WORK: THE PERFECT COMPLIMENT TO THE CHÂTEAU DUFRESNE

Montreal, July 28 2010- Guido Nincheri was an Italian artist who lived in Montreal at the beginning of the century. He is recognized as the artist who produced the largest number of Canadian works during the XXth century. Many of his works were deemed controversial, including frescoes inside the Difesa church in Little Italy as well as the frescoes of the Chateau Dufresne.

Montreal’s Italian Week will honour him on Sunday August 15th, 2010 at 1.30 pm at Chateau Dufresne. His grandson will guide you through 1300 models and works, documenting his work in North America, the places he visited, including his studio in Hochelaga-Maisonneuve and the church where his frescoes adorn the ceilings in Italian renaissance style.
